



What we do




- We meet specific needs from the developing world at regional and country level

- WE DO NOT produce products of more general archival use or longer-term professional programmes which are the remit of PCOM




What we did in our first full year 2010-11

- suggested other funding opportunities to some applicants



Advice on applying



- This scheme is about practical development. Applications should be from you individually or from an archival organisation
- Be sure that you can manage the project in the timescale
- Be precise about what you are going to do and how
- Be clear about the outcomes for you and for your organisation and how they will be sustainable
- Report on the results and account for the money spent



What do you have to do to be considered?



- Go to the FIDA section of the ICA website
- It is in French Spanish and English
- Fill in right form for an **individual** or a **group** application in English, French or Spanish
- BE aware: We will normally reply to you in English
- Review your organisation against the Checklist so you know where you have development needs which FIDA may be able to help you with
- Include referees NOT from your own organisation
