

## SIO Recommendations

### 39<sup>th</sup> ICA/SIO Annual Meeting, Brussels, 12 - 14 June 2013

1. SIO acknowledges the importance of digital preservation and recognises the value of digital preservation maturity models, it recommend their development into fully operational tools, to be distributed as widely as possible.
2. SIO acknowledges the impact of WEB 2.0, and recommends the adoption of these technologies into tools to make available SIO information to its members.
3. Following the recommendation of the ICA Secretariat, SIO encourages outreach activities by its members to increase and consolidate membership with international organisations.
4. SIO acknowledges the importance of good governance and encourages the development of a common methodology on access to archives based on the exchange of best practices by its members.
5. SIO recognises the fundamental importance of archival preservation and notes the growing impact of data protection and privacy rules. SIO will follow and report regularly to its members on this fundamental issue.
6. SIO is open to explore possibilities of cooperation with academic institutions, donors and other international organisations with the aim of sharing expertise. The SIO also endorses constituted and future working groups and commits its support to their activities.
