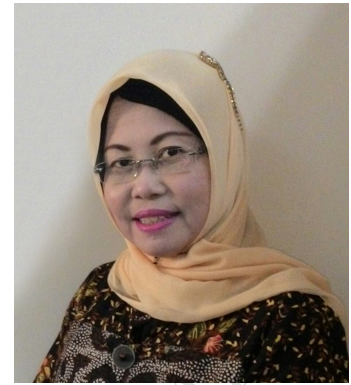

She spent several years developing the Indonesian Archival Information Network and System that provides access to national records and archives information throughout Indonesia. She received an Archivist Award in 1992 for her contributions to the archival field.

HISTORICAL BIOGRAPHY

Desi Pratiwi was born in 1964 in Jakarta. After studying archives and records management at the University of Indonesia, she joined the National Archives of Indonesia in December 1986, where she has worked for almost 30 years, supporting records management improvement programmes in Indonesia; contributing to seminars, workshops and education programs; and participating in research projects. She received an Archivist Award from the Minister of Administrative Reform in 1992 for her contribution to archival practice across government agencies and state owned enterprises. During 2006 and 2008 she served as archivist for the Commission of Truth and Friendship of Indonesia and Timor-Leste in Bali. She also made substantial contributions to the development and implementation of legislation for archives and records management including the Archives Act No. 43 of 2009. In 2012, she went on to play a pivotal role in the development of a system (called SIKN) that can collect records and archives information including digital copies from Indonesian government agencies and archival institutions and then provide the information and copies online (called JIKN) at www.jikn.go.id. She is now the Director for the Indonesian Archival Information Network and System of the National Archives of Indonesia (ANRI). This role allows her to apply her passion for providing online access to national archival information and promoting this throughout Indonesia. Desi Pratiwi has been involved in several professional development programs of ICA since 2006, including coordinating the project to translate *Training the Trainer* Resource Pack into Indonesian (2006), the project to translate the *Universal Declaration on Archives* into Indonesian (2012), organizing the Executive Board Meeting of SARBICA in Ujung Pandang (1995), organizing the international archival seminar of SARBICA in Bandung (2013), organizing the Executive Board Meeting of ICA in Bali (April 2015), and organizing the Indonesian archival exhibition published online for the International Archival Day on 9th June 2015 (incorporated into the ICA website).
